### Call to Order

### Approval of Minutes

Diana Hykes motioned to approve the agenda as written, Jane Mitchell seconded and the motion was passed unanimously.

### Financial Status

- The Parks and Recreation Fund account balance is \$49,056.63.
- There are no payables at this time.
- The 2013 Final Land Grant for \$4,650 has been submitted. It is expected to take 6 weeks, from 08/19/15, to process.
- 2016 Budget talks are in process.

### New Business

- Yard Sale (9/12/15)
  - Flyers are up.
  - Jane Mitchell and Diana Hykes to assist with the Yard Sale.
  - 1 Table has been reserved at this time.
- Harvest Festival
  - Steve Luckie will be running the Festival planning.

- Boiler Plate flyer was reviewed. *Post Meeting Note, the Flyer was reviewed and approved for distribution.*
- Mike Masley voiced concern over Mosquitoes, and West Nile Virus, however the belief is the weather will limit the concern.
- Stuart Park Benches
  - One Bench was vandalized.
  - Nick Mallios made a presentation in which he requested the ability and approval to place a bench in memory of John Cuff. John is a Veteran, who enjoyed, taught, and promoted fishing in the Yellow Breeches. Nick Mallios, and others, will pay to construct, and maintain the bench. Bench is proposed to go in place near the Dock. Jane Mitchell and Molly Baehr motioned, and seconded to accept the request. This was approved.

**Old Business**

- Lindenwood Park
  - Lindenwood Park has paving equipment staged at the site. Excess stone material will be left in the parking lot, and the lot will be left in a better condition than it was found.
- Stuart Park
  - Well and Septic to proceed under a separate approval, and this work should bid, and begin soon.
  - This work will include removal of 3 trees that were damaged in recent storm events.
  - Location of the proposed building was discussed.
  - An electrical upgrade at the Mill will be required for new construction.
  - Size of the building is proposed to be 20'x24'. This will include a small mechanical room.
  - Adam Felix and Diana Hykes to work on the scope of work. Jane Mitchell and Molly Baehr offered to assist with Grant paperwork.
