Engineer Jacobs said he drove past the site on his way to the meeting this evening and it seems as though the grass has seeded since last season. Chairman Smith inquired if there had been any additional comments or complaints from the affected residents. Manager Barrick stated the Township has received no additional complaints or comments. Engineer Jacobs advised the board to not pay the residual amount due in the total of \$788.15 due to the contractor not meeting the contract requirements.


