CURB WATER POLLUTION

Start in Your Own Back Yard

- ◆ Set mower height to 3 inches or higher.
- ◆ Retain grass clippings and chopped leaves onsite.
- ◆ Keep clippings/leaves out of streams, drains & off the street.
- ◆ Fertilizers for your lawn . . . do you need them?
- ◆ Test your soil, consult a professional or certified applicator.
- ◆ Maximize the slow-release nitrogen in your fertilizer.
- ◆ Start with low amounts or fewer applications.
- ◆ Apply only during the growing season and check the weather.
- ◆ Do not fertilize/use pesticides within 15-20' of a stream.
- ◆ Sweep granulated chemicals back onto your lawn.
- ◆ Garden fertilizer alternatives include compost/manure.

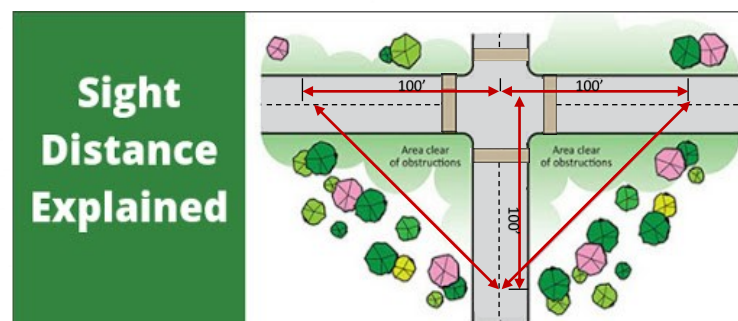

CLEAR SIGHT TRIANGLES

As per Dickinson Township Zoning Ordinance Chapter 205-22A: Corner Lots: No obstruction to vision exceeding 30" in height above street level shall be erected or maintained within a 100' clear sight triangle formed by the centerline of intersecting streets. Due to safety concerns this could cause when pulling out of intersections, this Ordinance will be enforced.

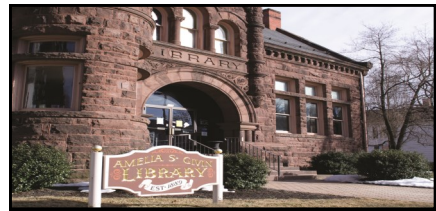

In April of 2021, Vector Control will begin treating water in vernal pools that may become issues due to mosquitoes. In May of 2021 we will begin our surveillance for West Nile Virus once again. We will be surveilling the entire county and placing weekly data collection traps in most municipalities. We will follow the same guidelines as the 2020 season.



Shown above is the data collection trap we use to collect the species of mosquito that commonly carries West Nile Virus



Areas of standing water like the one pictured are common throughout the county and are monitored for virus activity frequently.

Septic Pumping/Inspection Reminder

The Township staff has forwarded reminders to residents requiring septic pumping in 2021. It is required that every owner of an individual sewage system have septage or other solids removed from the treatment tank at least once every 3 years. Proof of pumping and/or inspection shall be provided by the owner of the individual system within 30 days of the date of service to the Township, along with the required \$10 administrative fee, which helps to offset administrative costs. Please visit www.dickinsontownship.org for more information, including required forms and a list of approved septic haulers.

The alternative is to have a Registered Septic Hauler or Inspection Company perform a "sludge test" to verify there is no more than 1/3 of the capacity of the tank filled with solids. If this is the case, you will receive a waiver from the pumping requirements until the next 3 year cycle. A report must be submitted for the solids inspection, along with the \$10 administrative fee.
