

CLEAR SIGHT TRIANGLES

As per Dickinson Township Zoning Ordinance Chapter 205-22A: Corner Lots: No obstruction to vision exceeding 30" in height above street level shall be erected or maintained within a 100' clear sight triangle formed by the centerline of intersecting streets. Due to the safety concerns this could cause when pulling out of intersections, this Ordinance will be enforced.





Septic Pumping/Inspection Reminder

The Township staff has forwarded the second pumping reminders of the year in September to residents who still need their septic systems pumped in 2022. It is required that every owner of an individual sewage system have septage or other solids removed from the treatment tank at least once every 3 years. Proof of pumping and/or inspection shall be provided by the owner of the individual system within 30 days of the date of service to the Township, along with the required \$10 septic inspection fee, which helps to offset administrative costs. Please visit www.dickinsontownship.org for more information, including required forms and a list of approved septic haulers.

The alternative is to have a Registered Septic Hauler or Inspection Company perform a "sludge test" to verify there is no more than 1/3 of the capacity of the tank filled with solids. If this is the case, you will receive a waiver from the pumping requirements until the next 3 year cycle. A report must be submitted for the solids inspection, along with the \$10 inspection fee.
