**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DICKINSON, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST FOR A DIRT, GRAVEL, AND LOW VOLUME ROAD MAINTENANCE PROGRAM GRANT OF UP TO \$230,000.00 FROM PENNSYLVANIA STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION THROUGH CUMBERLAND COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT FOR A PORTION OF WEST YELLOW BREECHES ROAD FOR DRAINAGE AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS AND DESIGNATING ROB KOLE, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, AND JILL LOVETT, TOWNSHIP MANAGER, AS THE OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS AND ASSIST IN OBTAINING THE GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, Dickinson Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania (the “Township” or “Applicant”) desires to improve a portion of West Yellow Breeches Road for drainage and road improvements in the Township (the “Stuart Park Improvements items”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has identified the Dirt, Gravel and Low Volume Road Program Grant as a potential source of funding for these drainage and road improvements for a portion of West Yellow Breeches Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has determined that the Stuart Park Improvements items will promote the health, safety and welfare of the local community, and therefore the Township supports a grant application; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of Dickinson Township, that the Applicant hereby requests a Dirt, Gravel, and Low Volume Road Program Grant of up to \$230,000.00 from the PA State Conservation Commission through Cumberland County Conservation District to be used for a portion of West Yellow Breeches Road. Improvements include the reconstruction of the roadway, removing trees in the Right-of-Way, improving the stormwater infrastructure and drainage for safe and reliable transportation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Applicant agrees to the “Terms and Conditions of Grant” included with the application package; also, there is no grant match requirement. The maximum grant amount for this request is up to \$230,000.00; anything over that amount would need to be funded by the “Township”.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Applicant does hereby designate Rob Kole, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, and Jill Lovett, Township Manager, as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between the Township and the PA State Conservation Commission through Cumberland County Conservation District to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.

**DULY ADOPTED**, pursuant to the authority granted to the Township of Dickinson under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in lawful session duly assembled on this 6th day of May 2026.


