RESOLUTION NO. 2026-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DICKINSON, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REAL ESTATE AND DESIGNATING OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE PURCHASE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 53 P.S. § 66502(a), of the Second Class Township Code, Dickinson Township (the "Township") may purchase, acquire by gift or otherwise, hold, lease, let and convey, by sale or lease, any real estate and personal property it judges to be in the best interest of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has previously leased the property located at 161 Old State Road, Carlisle, Pennsylvania, and further identified as Cumberland County Tax Parcel Number 08-40-2648-002EX (the "Property"), from the owner and now desires to purchase said land for municipal purposes including the storage of Public Works equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Township deems the purchase of the Property to be in the best interest of its citizens and the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Dickinson Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference thereto and made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The Board of Supervisors of Dickinson Township hereby authorizes the execution of an Agreement of Sale for the purchase of the Property for the purchase price of Eighty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$80,000.00).

SECTION 3: The Board of Supervisors of Dickinson Township hereby designates Rob Kole, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, and Jill Lovett, Township Manager, as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between the Township and the Carlisle Area School District to facilitate the Township's purchase of the Property.

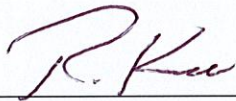
SECTION 4: All provisions of previous resolutions or ordinances which are contrary to this Resolution are expressly repealed.

SECTION 5: If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution is for any reason found unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts hereof. It is hereby declared the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Dickinson that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included therein.

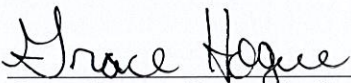
SECTION 6: This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

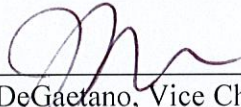
